We are a nonprofit organization supporting both female university students and young professionals raised in Germany, who are Black and Women of Color (BIWOC) and/or from immigrant families, in all job and career-related topics.

Our mission

Considering their qualification in comparison to their share of the population, they are grossly underrepresented in the German academic job market. And it is our ambition to change that. To accomplish that, we also work with employers who want their staff to become more diverse.

What do we offer?

Innovative Diversity Recruiting

Access to a network of more than 1.500 female high potentials (“swans”) with high cultural and social diversity.

Credible Employer Branding

Authentic and attractive positioning with potential applicants, multipliers and the general public.

Pioneering role

SWANS partners are pioneers at an intersectional approach to diversity (e.g. overlap of gender, race, class and religion).

CSR and Social Impact

Holistic support of our “swans” on top of existing recruitment efforts. Enabling a non-material support program comparable to a scholarship that consists of seminars, network and alumnae work.





Why diversity?

77 percent of employees are more likely to apply to an employer that lives diversity (Stepstone Diversity Study 2021).

Companies with high diversity are profitable above average (McKinsey 2011, 2015, 2018, 2020, Harvard Business School 2018, US National Bureau of Economic Research 2019).

Two thirds of companies in Germany haven't implemented any diversity management measures, only 19 percent are planning specific measures in the future (Charta für Vielfalt Study 2020).
